

ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, 1944,
(No. 17 of 1944)

UNDER SECTION 4(1) (d) OF THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE OLD AGE PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1953, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Old Age Pensions Order, 1954.

2. For the purposes of paragraph (d) of sub-section (1) of section four of the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, 1944,* as amended by section two of the Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953,** the prescribed amount shall be —

- (a) in the case of a person ordinarily resident in the Georgetown area twelve dollars per mensem; and
- (b) in the case of a person resident elsewhere in the Colony than in the Georgetown area ten dollars per mensem.
