UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1953 (No. 10 OF 1953) IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Order, 1954.
- 2. Owing to the presence therein of cases of Foot and Mouth Disease the area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the abovementioned Ordinance, an area infected with Foot and Mouth Disease.
 - 3. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.

SCHEDULE.

That area bounded as follows —

On the north, by the parallel of latitude 5° N;

On the east, by the boundary between the Colony and Dutch Guiana;

On the south, by the boundary between the Colony and Brazil; On the west, by the Ireng and Takatu Rivers.
