

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936,  
(No. 29 of 1936)

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936  
AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES  
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1953 (No. 10 OF 1953) IT IS HEREBY  
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Order, 1954.
2. Owing to the presence therein of cases of Foot and Mouth Disease the area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the abovementioned Ordinance, an area infected with Foot and Mouth Disease
3. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette

## SCHEDULE.

That area bounded as follows —

On the north and west by the boundary between the Colony and Venezuela;

On the east by parallel of longitude 60° W as far north as the 8th parallel of latitude West, thence in an easterly direction on the 8th parallel of latitude West as far as the Waini River thence down the Waini River to its mouth;

On the south, by the boundary between the Colony and Brazil
