

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936,  
(No. 29 of 1936)

UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 13 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1953, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Wild Carnivores) Order, 1954.
2. The animals specified in the First Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "wild carnivores") shall be included in the definition of the expression "animal" in section 2 of the Animal Diseases Ordinance, 1936.
3. Subject to the provisions of any Order made under the Animal Diseases Ordinance, 1936, or any Ordinance amending the same, for the time being in force, the importation into the Colony of any cat, dog or wild carnivore from any place out of the Colony other than a place specified in the Second Schedule to this Order shall, from the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette, be prohibited.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

Wild or zoological specimens of fox, wolf, mongoose, ferret, stoat, weasel, wild dog and wild cat including tiger, puma, cheetah, ocelot, jaguar and mountain lion.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

1. The United Kingdom.
2. Eire.
3. The British West Indian territories, other than British Honduras.
