

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT  
(SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, 1948,

(Uo. 16 of 1948)

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE 1948, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Desmond Montague Edghill, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the areas of lands described in paragraphs 5 and 6 of the Schedule to the above Ordinance, and set out at paragraphs 1 and 2 respectively of the Schedule hereto:

**SCHEDULE**

(Areas of land to which this Order applies)

1. Section "F" in Plantation Den Amstel, West Coast, Demerara, and the lands in the rear thereof held under Grant No. 4154 and comprising an area of approximately 230 acres and bounded —

On the North by Section "E", Plantation Den Amstel;

On the East by the Western Boundary of the second and extra depths of Plantation Blenkenburg;

On the South by the Boereseire Service Canal; and

On the West by the eastern boundary of the second depth of Plantation Fellowship held under Grant No. 4281.

2. Tract held under Grant 4281 in the rear of Section "A" Plantation Fellowship, West Coast, Demerara and comprising an area of 151.88 acres and bounded —

On the North by Section "A", Plantation Fellowship;

On the East by Grant No. 4154 and Plantation Den Amstel;

On the South by the Boereseire Service Canal; and

On the West by the second and extra depths of Plantation Hague.
