

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

## THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, 1948.

(No. 16 of 1948).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, 1948, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Under section 2 of the above Ordinance, James Lawrence Yhap, Esquire, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the land described in paragraph 2 hereunder.

2. Under section 4(1) (a) of the above Ordinance, the Schedule to the said Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the area of land described in the Schedule hereto of the following paragraph —

“11. That portion of Plantation Rosignol situate on the left bank of the Berbice River comprising an area of approximately seventy five English acres and bounded:—

On the North by the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantation D'Edward and Rosignol commencing at a point approximately 530 feet west of the centre line of the Public Road and opposite the eastern boundary of Lots Nos. 1—22 section “C” as defined and shown on Plan by William Chalmers dated April, 1872 and extending eastward to a point approximately 660 feet east of the centre line of the Public Road;

On the East by a line commencing at a point in the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantations Blairmont and Rosignol and opposite the eastern edge of the sea dam as shown on a plan by E. C. H. Klautky, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 4th January, 1910, and extending northward along the eastern edge of the said sea dam and its prolongation across Plantation Rosignol to the eastern end of the northern boundary;

On the South by the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantations Blairmont and Rosignol commencing at a point opposite the eastern edge of the sea dam as shown on a plan by E. C. H. Klautky, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 4th January, 1910, and extending westwards to a point approximately 530 feet west of the centre line of the Public Road; and

On the West by a line commencing at a point in the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantations D'Edward and Rosignol opposite the eastern boundary of Lots Nos. 1—22 section “C” as defined and shown on a plan by William Chalmers, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated April 1872 and extending southward along the said eastern boundary of Lots Nos. 1—22 and its prolongation across Plantation Rosignol to the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantations Blairmont and Rosignol.”
