ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, 1940,

(No. 25 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 23(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, 1940, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

The Drainage and Irrigation Board is hereby directed to cause to be constructed—

(a) an irrigation supply canal in the area described in the Schedule hereunder;

(b) a canal head, a tail wall and outlet pipes in the irrigation supply canal referred to in paragraph (a) of this Order;

(c) cattle bridges across the irrigation supply canal referred to in paragraph (a) of this Order.

SCHEDULE

That portion of the Canals Polder Drainage and Irrigation Area described in the Sixth Schedule to the Drainage and Irrigation Ordinance, 1940 (No. 25 of 1940) bounded—

On the North by the common boundary between the Polder Canal known as "A" Line and the Boerasirie Service Canal from the western side of the Congervancy Dam to the common boundary between Plantations Java and Lust-tot-Rust;

On the East by the common boundary between Plantations Java and Lust-tot-Rust from the common boundary between the Polder Canal known as "A" Line and the Boerasirie Service Canal to the northern boundary of Canal No. 1;

On the South by the northern boundary of Canal No. 1 from the common boundary between Plantations Java and Lust-tot-Rust to the western side of the Conservancy Dam:

western side of the Conservancy Dam; On the West by the western side of the Conservancy Dam from the northern boundary of Canal No. 1 to the common boundary between the
