THE FIRE PREVENTION ORDINANCE, No. 19 of 1954).
UNDER SECTION 1(1) OF THE FIRE PREVENTION ORDINANCE,
1954. THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE

GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

The provisions of the Fire Prevention Ordinance, 1954, shall apply to the areas specified in the Schedule hereunder.

SCHEDULE.

- 1. The city of Georgetown and its environs bounded on the North by the Atlantic Ocean; on the East by the Company Path between Plantations Cummings Lodge and Industry, and its prolongation to the Lamaha Canal, thence along the Lamaha Canal to the prolongation of the common boundary between Plantations Rome and Eccles; on the South by the common boundary between Plantations Rome and Eccles, and its prolongation from the Demerara river eastwards to the Lamaha Canal, and on the West by the Demerara river.
- 2. The town of New Amsterdam comprising the area bounded on the North by the Ordinance Land; on the East by Plantations Smythfield and Vryheid; on the South by Plantation Overwinning; and on the West by the Berbice river.
- 3. The village of Bartica comprising the area bounded on the North by the Mazaruni river; on the East by the Essequibo river; on the South by the Mongreppo creek, and on the West by Seventh Avenue and its prolongation to its junction with the Mongreppo creek.
- 4. The area of the Corentyne District, situated between the villages of Springlands and Skeldon inclusive, commencing at the north-eastern corner of No. 75, bounded on the North by the northern boundary of No. 75; on the East by the Corentyne river; on the South, by the southern boundary of Grant No. 847; and on the West by the back boundaries of Grants Nos. 847, 467, 468, 466, 614 and Plantations Nos. 80, 79, 78, 77, 76 and 75.
