## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, 1944, (No. 17 of 1944).

UNDER SECTION 6 (2) OF THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, 1944, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Old Age Pensions (Appeal Board)

(Amendment) Order, 1954, and shall be construed with the Old Age Pensions (Appeal Board) Order, 1949\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "the Assistant Social Welfare Officer" in section 3 thereof, of

the words "the Social Welfare Officer".
3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1953.
