ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE RICE (CESS) ORDINANCE, 1952, (No. 6 of 1952).

WHEREAS by Section 3(1) of the Rice (Cess) Ordinance, 1952, it is provided that the Governor may, where it has been agreed between the Government of the Colony and the British Guiana Rice Marketing Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") that it is expedient so to do, by Order published in the Gazette, authorise and direct the Board to pay to the Financial Secretary a cess at such rate as may be specified in such Order, in respect of the proceeds of the sale of rice by the Board for consumption within the Colony;

AND WHEREAS it is provided under Section 3(3) of the said Ordinance that any Order made under the provisions of Section 3(1) thereof may, in like manner be varied or revoked by any subsequent Order;

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of the aforementioned powers it was provided by the Rice (Cess) Order, 1953*, that the cess required to be paid by the Rice (Cess) Order, 1952†, shall not be required to be paid during the year nineteen hundred and fifty-three;

AND WHEREAS the Government of the Colony and the Board have agreed that it is expedient that a cess on all rice sold by the Board for consumption within the Colony shall be paid by the Board to the Financial Secretary at the rate of two dollars and seventy cents per bag of one hundred and eighty pounds gross weight, with effect from the 1st day of October, 1953:

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby order as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Rice (Cess) Order, 1954.
- 2. Anything in the provisions of the Rice (Cess) Order, 1952†, or the Rice (Cess) Order, 1953*, to the contrary notwithstanding, the Board is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the Financial Secretary a cess on all rice sold by the Board at the rate of two dollars and seventy cents per bag of one hundred and eighty pounds gross weight, with effect from the 1st day of October, 1953.
- 3. The Rice (Cess) Order, 1952^+_1 , and the Rice (Cess) Order, 1953^*_1 , are hereby revoked.
