This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Construction) Order,
1954.

in the Schedule hereto.

New sea dam extending from McNabb dam to Dartmouth, Sea Defence
District No. 1, Essequibo Coast, at an estimated cost of sixty thousand
dollars.
