ORDER IN COUNCIL

UNDER

SECTION 44 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE,

Chapter 9.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 44 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance, Chapter 9, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, appoint the times and places for the sittings of the courts, other than the court of the Georgetown district, and may in like manner alter any of those times and places;

And whereas the Governor by Order in Council dated the 13th March, 1951 ordered and appointed the times and places of the sitting of the Magistrates' Court in the Berbice Judicial District;

And whereas it is desirable that the sittings of the said court holden at Blairmont in the said district should until further orders be held at New Amsterdam:

Now therefore the Governor in Council doth hereby order and appoint that the Magistrate's courtroom at New Amsterdam be substituted for the Magistrate's courtroom at Blairmont as the place for the sitting of the Magistrate's court in the Berbice Judicial District and the time for the sitting of the said court shall be the first Tuesday in every month commencing from Tuesday the 5th day of January, 1954.
