THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 23 (5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Construction) (No. 2) Order, 1957.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed the drainage and irrigation work described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

A Check Sluice in the vicinity of the junction of the Gibraltar/Courtland sideline trench and the cross trench across Courtland situate approximately 2,608 feet south of the Public Road within the Gibraltar/Courtland Drainage and Irrigation Area.
