ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, 1940,
(No. 25 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 13 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION
ORDINANCE, 1940, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Rosehall Village Corentyne
Drainage and Irrigation Order, 1955.

2. The area described in the schedule to this Order is hereby declared
to be a drainage and irrigation area and shall be known as the Rosehall
Village Corentyne Drainage and Irrigation Area.

SCHEDULE

That area bounded as follows:—

On the North:	by the Atlantic Ocean;
On the East :	by the common boundary between Rosehall Village District and Plantation Port Mourant;
On the South ; and West	by the common boundary between Rosehall Village District and Plantation Albion.
