

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES)
ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 9).

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 44 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance, Chapter 9, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, appoint the times and places for the sittings of the courts, other than the court of the Georgetown district, and may in like manner alter any of those times and places:

AND WHEREAS the Governor by Order in Council dated the 28th August, 1953, ordered and appointed the times and places of the sittings of the Magistrate's Courts in the West Demerara Judicial District:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the sittings of the court holden at Stewartville in the said district should be discontinued:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that sittings of the said court should be held henceforth at Leonora in the said West Demerara Judicial District:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor in Council doth hereby order and appoint that the Magistrate's courthouse at Leonora be substituted for the Magistrate's courthouse at Stewartville as a place for the sitting of the Magistrate's court in the West Demerara Judicial District, and the time for the sitting of the said court shall be Tuesday in every week commencing from Tuesday the 3rd day of January, 1956.

The Order in Council of the 28th of August, 1953* in so far as it relates to sittings of the Magistrate's Court at Stewartville, in the West Demerara Judicial District, is hereby revoked.
