ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,
(No. 69 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

Part III of the First Schedule to the Customs (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1952^{*}, as substituted by section 4 (2) of the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1953[†], and as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the addition after the sub-item "BRICK AND TILE MANUFACTURE" in item 34, of the following sub-item:—

"TOBACCO CULTIVATION, motor spirit for driving machinery and for use in approved vehicles necessary for the undertaking."
