UNDER SECTION 9 (5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, THE FOLLOWING ORDER
HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting No. 2) Order, 1956.

2. The works described in the schedule hereto shall vest in and become the property of the Board.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Trench between Plantation Rotterdam and Plantation Union extending from the Public Road to the sea wall.
- (2) Cross trench and dams lying approximately midway between the back boundary of Plantation Harlem, and the Railway line and extending in an easterly direction from the West sideline of Plantation Harlem to the Railway line.
- (3) The irrigation supply trench and dams of Plantation Windsor Forest from the Boerasirie Service Canal to the R.C. Weir situate in the Windsor Forest Middle-walk approximately 2 miles south of the Railway line.
