ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE, (Chapter 12).

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 45 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance that the Governor may, by order in council appoint the times and places for the sittings of the courts, other than the court of the Georgetown district, and may in like manner alter any of those times and places:

AND WHEREAS the Governor, by order in council dated the 8th day of March, 1956, ordered and appointed the times and places for the sittings of the Magistrate's Court in the Berbice Judicial District:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the sittings of the Court holden in the police compound at Weldaad in the aforesaid Judicial District should be discontinued:

AND WHEREAS a Magistrate's courthouse has been erected at Weldaad in the said Berbice Judicial District:

NOW THEREFORE the Governor in Council doth hereby order and appoint that sittings of the Magistrate's Court at Weldaad in the aforesaid Judicial District be hereafter held at the Magistrate's courthouse referred to above, and that the times for the sittings of the said court shall be the second and fourth Thursday in every month commencing on Thursday the 28th day of February, 1957.
