THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1957.

2. Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the substitution of the figures, "\$0.45", for the figures, "\$1.00", as the rate of export duty per ton on bauxite, calcined, appearing as item 2 in the table of Export duties.

3. Part III of the first schedule of the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition of the following new item:

"61. Fuel oil, caustic soda, soda ash, lime, limestone and filter cloth when imported for use in the manufacture of alumina."
