THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 173).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. Under section 4(1) of the above Ordinance, the land specified in the petition of Tyrell Levy and others of Parika, Essequibo River, in the county of Essequibo, which said land is described in the schedule hereto, shall be subject to the provisions of the abovementioned Ordinance.
- 2. Under section 5 (1) (a) of the abovementioned Ordinance, Robert Leslie Dewar, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the officer to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot, the lands described in the schedule hereto.

Plantation Parika situate on the right bank Essequibo River, county of Essequibo, comprising approximately 1123 acres and bounded—

On the north—by the Essequibo River; On the east—by Plantation Hydronie; On the south—by Crown Lands; On the west—by Plantation Hyde Park.
