ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 162).

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 54A OF THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE, AS INSERTED BY SECTION 4 OF THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. The fees payable to any public officer discharging the duties of a Superintendent Registrar or Registrar as the case may be, shall be the fees payable under sections 32, 33, 34, 35, 51 and 54 of the Registration of Births and Deaths Ordinance:

Provided that the public officers enumerated in the first column of the schedule hereto shall be paid the fee set out opposite their offices in the third column of the said schedule.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1956.
