## ORDER IN COUNCIL MADE UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE,

## (Chapter 173)

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—
