

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 258)

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 2) Order, 1956.

2. In this Order —

“fodder” means fodder of any kind brought with swine;

“litter” means any straw, hay or other substance used as bedding for any swine and includes excreta of such swine;

“canned” means properly sterilized and supplied in hermetically sealed containers.

3. Swine, carcasses of swine, ham, bacon, lard, hoofs, bristles, hides and other by-products of swine, fodder and litter of swine, containers, crates, cages and receptacles used to convey swine or any part or by-product of swine shall not be brought into the colony from any of the territories set out in the schedule hereto.

4. This Order shall not apply to carcasses of swine, ham, bacon or lard when canned nor to the containers thereof.

5. The Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) Order*, as amended by the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 3) (Amendment) Order, 1955**, is hereby revoked.
