MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTIONS 47 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Road Traffic (Georgetown) Order, 1956*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby varied by the repeal of articles 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 12 thereof, and of the first schedule thereto.
