ORDER IN COUNCIL
Made Under
THE SHOPS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 118).

UNDER THE PROVISIO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS ORDINANCE,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision)
(M. Idris Deen) Order, 1956.

2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops Ordinance,
but subject to the provisions of this Order, M. Idris Deen (hereinafter
referred to as “the Proprietor”) is hereby permitted to open his shop at
No. 79 Village, Skeldon, Corentyne, Berbice, during the hours set out in
the schedule hereto:

SCHEDULE

Hours during which the Proprietor’s shop at No. 79 Village, Skeldon,
Corentyne, Berbice, may be open)

- (a) Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays —
8.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon; 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.
- (b) Saturdays —8.00 a.m. to 12 noon.
