ORDER IN COUNCIL MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 16(2) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Air Mail Postage Rates (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Air Mail Postage Rates Order, 1955*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Orders amending the same.
- 2. The schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the rates of postage for Light Air Letters set out therein of the rates of postage for Light Air Letters set out hereunder in respect of the destinations mentioned:—

 (i) Antigua, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Honduras, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Jamaica, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent, Tortola (Br. Virgin Islands), Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Island
 6 cents

- (ii) Aruba, Argentine, Bolivia, Bonaire, Brazil, Falkland Islands, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Curacao, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras Republic, Mexico, Martinique, Nicaragua, Panama Canal Zone, Panama Republic, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, Saba and St. Eustatius, St. Martin, Uruguay, Venezuela, Virgin Islands (U.S.A.) 9 cents.
- (iii) Surinam 8 cents
- (iv) Other territories, colonies or countries not named above 12 cents
- 3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1957.
