Made Under
THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 191).

UNDER SECTION 9 (2) OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Construction) Order, 1956.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed the sea defence described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

New sea dam extending from Better Hope to Somerset and Berks, Sea Defence District No. 1, Essequibo Coast, at an estimated cost of sixty thousand dollars.
