## ORDER IN COUNCIL

## THE RENT RESTRICTION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 186).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE RENT RESTRICTION ORDINANCE,  
THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Rent Restriction Extension (Lots Nos. 78-79 Country District, Courantyne) (No. 1) Order, 1957.
2. In this Order—  
“the Ordinance” means the Rent Restriction Ordinance.
3. The operation of the Ordinance is hereby extended to the area described in the schedule hereto.
4. The standard rent of any house, building or land in the area described in the schedule hereto to which the Ordinance applies shall be that defined in section 2 of the Ordinance..

**SCHEDULE**

That area of Lots Nos. 78-79 Country District commencing on the left bank Courantyne River at the northern boundary of part of the front lands of Plns. Eliza and Mary now known as Springlands as shown on a plan by M.V. Grant, Government Surveyor, dated 29th June, 1920, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as Plan No. 3229, and extending thence to the eastern edge of the Public Road, thence in a southerly direction along the Public Road for a distance of about 900 feet to a point opposite the northern boundary of the area surveyed for the Village Office Compound, as shown on a plan by O. E. Fung-On, Government Surveyor, dated 14th January, 1952, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as Plan No. 5969, thence across the Public Road and along the northern and western boundaries of the said Village Office Compound, thence eastward along the southern boundary of the said Village Office Compound to the western edge of the trench along the western side of the Public Road, thence southward along the western edge of the trench along the western side of the Public Road for a distance of approximately 50 feet, thence eastward to the left bank Courantyne River, thence downwards along the left bank Courantyne River to the point of commencement.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The provisions of the Rent Restriction Ordinance, Cap. 186, were extended to Lots 78-79 Country District, Courantyne, on the 21st of May 1952. The boundaries of this district have been enlarged and this Order has the effect of extending the Rent Restriction Ordinance to include the enlarged area.
