UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

No proprietor of any estate within the area described in the schedule to Order in Council No. 15 of 1957, published in the Gazette of the 23rd March, 1957, (which defined the proposed boundaries of the Black Bush Polder Drainage and Irrigation Area) shall bear any proportion of the capital costs of the proposed works.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

All except a small part of the lands in the proposed Black Bush Polder Drainage and Irrigation Area (Blocks I & II, Courantyne) are Crown Lands and this Order provides that the proprietors of those portions of the area which are privately owned shall not be required to bear any part of the capital costs of the proposed works.
