THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 191).

UNDER SECTION 9 (2) OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Construction) (No. 2) Order, 1957.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed the sea defence described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

New sea defence dam on the eastern side of Plantation McKinnon's in Sea Defence District No. 3, Leguan, Essequibo River, at an estimated cost of two thousand six hundred dollars (\$2,600).
