# THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 174).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. In pursuance of section 2 of the District Lands Partition and Reallotment (Special Procedure) Ordinance, Michael Alexander Phang, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the land referred to in paragraph 2 hereunder.

2. In pursuance of section 4(1) (a) of the District Lands Partition and Re-allotment (Special Procedure) Ordinance, the schedule to the said Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the area of land described in the schedule to this Order.

### SCHEDULE

Craig Village District comprising the estates of Good Success and Craig situate on the East Bank of the Demerara River, in the County of Demerara, British Guiana, bounded.

On the North by Golden Grove;

On the South by New Hope;

On the East by Crown land held under Permission 10972; and

On the West by the Demerara River, and

containing an area of approximately 676 acres, the residential area being laid down and defined on a plan by G. R. M. Pollard, Sworn Land Surveyor dated the 1st June, 1874, copy of which plan is in the Lands and Mines Department as Plan No. 6842 and the back lands being laid down and defined on a plan by H. I. Perkins, Sworn Land Surveyor dated 17th August, 1894, a copy of which plan is recorded in the Lands and Mines Department as Plan No. 1038.
