ORDER IN COUNCIL Made Under THE PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE, 1956, (No. 36 of 1956).

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 49 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, 1956, that the Ordinance shall come into operation on the appointed day:
