Made Under

THE IMMIGRATION ACT

(Cap. 14:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE IMMIGRATION ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER : —

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Passports) ^{Citation.} Order 1984.
2. Except as otherwise provided in this order the pass- ^{Visa re-}port issued to a subject or citizen of any foreign country shall ^{quired ex-} not be accepted as such under section 5 of the Act unless the ^{cept in} passport bears a Guyanese consular ^{cases speci-} visa valid for Guyana.
3. (1) Paragraph 2 shall not apply where the passport ^{Exemptions.} is issued by any of the foreign countries specified in the Schedule.
(2) The Minister may by notification in the Gazette exempt passports issued to subject or citizens of any foreign country, not being a country specified in the Schedule, from the provisions of paragraph 2, and such exemptions may be general or subject to such conditions, restrictions, limitations or exceptions as are specified in the order.
4. The Immigration (Passports) Order* is hereby revoked. ^{Revocation.}
