IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 8 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL
ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ACT, I
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Ministers, Members of the National Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Order (No. 2) 1984 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1984, except in respect of the provisions relating to a Parliamentary Secretary and Every other Member of the National Assembly which shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1984.

2. The Schedule to the Act is hereby amended as follows —

- (a) in paragraph 1, by the substitution for the words "other than the Prime Minister" of the words "(other than the Prime Minister) and every Deputy Prime Minister" and for the words "\$24,000", "\$22,800", "\$21,600", "\$18,000", "\$15,000", "\$9,000", "\$22,800", "\$6,000", "\$14,400" and "\$4,200" of the words "\$60,000", "\$50,400", "\$42,000", "\$30,000", "\$18,000", "\$12,000", "\$50,400", "\$9,600", "\$24,000" and "\$7,200" respectively;

- (b) in paragraph 2, by the substitution for the words “\$3,000” where they occur for the second and third times of the words “\$4,800”;
- (c) in paragraph 3, by the substitution for the words “(other than the Prime Minister)” of the words “(other than the Prime Minister) and every Deputy Prime Minister” and for the words “\$3,000” and “\$1,800” of the words “\$6,000”;
- (d) in paragraph 4, by the substitution —
 - (i) in subparagraph (a) for the words “\$1,000” of the words “\$1,500”;
 - (ii) in subparagraph (b) for the words “(other than the Prime Minister)” of the words “(other than the Prime Minister), every Deputy Prime Minister” and for the words “\$500” of the words “\$700”;
 - (iii) in subparagraph (c) for the words “A Senior Minister” of the words “A Senior Minister and every other Minister” and for the words “\$350” of the words “\$700”;
 - (iv) in subparagraph (d) for the words “\$600” of the words “\$700”.
