

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 150).

UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bagotstown–Peter's Hall Village District (Elections) Order, 1960.

2. For the purpose of the election of councillors, the Bagotstown–Peter's Hall Village District, on the right bank of the Demerara River, County of Demerara, is hereby divided into two divisions, namely the Bagotstown Division and the Peter's Hall Division, the boundaries of which are described in the schedule hereto.

3. The number of councillors appointed to be elected by each division shall be as follows :—

- (a) by the Bagotstown Division, five councillors; and
- (b) by the Peter's Hall Division, four councillors.

SCHEDULE

1. (Boundaries of the Bagotstown Division)

On the north by the public road, and the sideline dam between Plantations Peter's Hall and Eccles.

On the east by a navigation trench about 80 roods from the public road.

On the south by the shipping trench of Peter's Hall Estate and a line being the prolongation of a dam forming the southern boundary of the Chapel Lands, across the public road until it meets the navigation trench which forms the eastern boundary.

On the west by the eastern side of the River dam on the bank of the Demerara River.

2. (Boundaries of the Peter's Hall Division).

On the north by the inner or southern edge of the dam running alongside the shipping canal.

On the east by the public road.

On the south by the public road and a line in continuation of its north edge running west to the western boundary.

On the west by the inner or eastern edge of the river dam.
