ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955.  
(No. 30 of 1955).

UNDER SECTION 9 (5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting) Order, 1960.
2. The works described in the schedule hereto shall vest in and become the property of the Board.

SCHEDULE.

- (a) A greenheart check sluice situated in Plantation Land of Plenty on the east dam of the Mainstay high level canal approximately 600 feet south of the Land of Plenty/Mainstay boundary; and
  - (b) A greenheart check sluice situated in Plantation Land of Plenty on the west dam of the Mainstay high level canal approximately 600 feet south of the Land of Plenty/ Mainstay boundary;
- all within the Three Friends Walton Hall Drainage and Irrigation Area.
