UNDER SECTIONS 16 (2) AND 17 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

As from the 1st day of March, 1960, the rates of postage and fees for services set out in the schedules to the Order in Council* made under the Post and Telegraph Ordinance** on the 6th January, 1960, shall be the rates and fees required to be paid under the said Ordinance in pursuance of sections 2 and 3 respectively of the Order in Council† made thereunder on the 29th December, 1950; and the rates of postage and fees for services set out in the schedules to the Order in Council‡ made under the said Ordinance on the 17th October, 1956, shall be the rates and fees required to be paid as aforesaid until the 29th day of February, 1960.
