ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 33 of 1958).

UNDER THE PROVISIO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shops Hours (Special Provision) (Singer Sewing Company) Order, 1960.
2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, Singer Sewing Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") is hereby permitted to open its shop at Mackenzie, Demerara River, during the hours set out in the schedule hereto.
3. The Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Singer Sewing Company) Order, 1955*, is hereby revoked.
4. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.
