UNDER THE PROVISION TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDA-TION) ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Shops Hours (Special Provision) (Cromarty) Order, 1960.

2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, shops in the area known as Cromarty, Corentyne, Berbice, are hereby permitted to open during the hours prescribed in the schedule hereto.

Thursdays and Fridays	3.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.

Public Holidays	6.30 a.m. to 10.00 a.m.
(c) Saturdays and on	6.30 a.m. to 10.00 a.m.
Christmas Eve	3.00 p.m. to 8.45 p.m.

3. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.
