ORDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

(Chapter 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Offices for the Public Service Ministry) Order 1982 made on the 15th day of February, 1982, the described in the Schedule to that Order together with all buildings and erections thereon was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS by the said Order the Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purposes therein mentioned;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the land together with the buildings and erections thereon to be acquired were laid before the Minister;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land, together with the buildings and erections thereon, described in the Schedule to this Order, is required for the public work aforesaid

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Offices for the Public Service Ministry) Order 1983.

SCHEDULE

That parcel of land known as Lot numbered 63 (sixty-three) known in the books of the Town Clerk as Lot numbered 16 (sixteen) or Lot 63 (sixty-three) and formerly known in the Receiver's Books as number 55 (fifty-five), High Street in the Kingston District in the City of Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, Guyana, together with the buildings and erections thereon surveyed and defined on a plan by R. Niranjana, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 17th December, 1982 and recorded on 12th January, 1983 at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown as plan No. 19884.

The boundaries of the area surveyed commence at a nail in concrete marked RN at the South Western corner of the said lot 33.0 feet east of the centre line of High Street and 526.0 feet north of the centre line of Barrack Street and proceed thence N14° 41' (T) 65.5 feet, thence N104° 50' (T) 183.0 feet thence N194° 41' (T) 65.5 feet thence N248° 50' (T) 183.0 feet to the point of commencement. The said lot 63 High Street, Kings contains an area of 0.2752 acres.
