

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE MINING ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 36(1) OF THE MINING ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merume Mining Area (Closing) Order, 1960.
2. The area of unoccupied Crown lands as described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared closed to prospecting or mining or the locating of claims under any prospecting licence for the mineral known as merumite or chromite.

SCHEDULE

A tract of Crown land situate on both banks of the Merume river, right bank of the Mazaruni river, commencing at the mouth of Apakai creek, and extending thence due west for about 5 miles to the foothills of the Merume Mountains. thence in a southerly direction along the foothills of the Merume Mountains for about 8 miles to the Merume Gorge and Falls thence in a north-easterly direction along the foothills for about 10 miles to the source of Massanapah creek, right bank of the Merume river and thence in a straight line for about 6 miles back to the point of commencement, and containing an approximate area of 35 square miles.
