ORDER IN COUNCIL  
MADE UNDER  
THE MINING ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 36(1) OF THE MINING ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY  
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wamara Hill Mining Area (Closing) Order, 1960.
2. The area of unoccupied Crown lands as described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting or mining or the locating of claims under any prospecting licence for all or any minerals valuable minerals or precious stones.

SCHEDULE

A tract of Crown land situate on the right bank of the Demerara river, commencing at the mouth of the Ibaru river and extending thence due east for 10 miles, thence due north for 2 miles, thence due west to the right bank of the Demerara river, thence upwards along the right bank of the Demerara river back to the point of commencement, and containing an approximate area of 20 square miles.
