ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

(CHAPTER 280)

UNDER SECTION 50 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Parking (Georgetown) Order, 1960.

2. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park in the Cemetery Road, between its junctions with D'Urban Street and Sussex Street.

3. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park on the eastern side of Russell Street between its junctions with Princes Street and Sussex Street.

4. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park on the southern side of D'Urban Street between its junctions with Vlissingen Road and High Street.

5. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever, drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park on the northern side of New Market Street between its junctions with Main Street and Water Street.

6. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park on the eastern side of King Street between its junctions with South Street and North Street.

7. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park on the western side of Queen Street south of Hope Street.
