THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, (Chapter 179).

UNDER THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Under section 6 of the aforementioned Ordinance it is hereby declared that the parcel of land described in the schedule hereto is required for a public work, namely a pumping station.

SCHEDULE

A tract of land, containing an area of 8.592 English acres, situate on the right bank of the Canje Creek, in the County of Berbice and the Colony of British Guiana, the boundaries of which are as follows:—

Commencing at a greenheart paal marked P.P. on the southern boundary of Grant No. 5060 465 feet east of an iron paal marked D.L.M. on the southwestern extremity of Grant No. 5060 and extending thence N 47° 39′ 38″ E (Tr) for a distance of 490 feet to the northern boundary of Grant No. 5060, thence N 77° 52′ 23″ E (Tr) along the aforesaid northern boundary of Grant No. 5060 for a distance of 285 feet, thence S 47° 39′ 38″ W (Tr) for a distance of 750 feet, thence S 42° 20′ 22″ E (Tr) for a distance of 330 feet, thence S 47° 39′ 38″ W (Tr) for a distance of 520 feet to an iron paal marked D. & I.D. on the right bank of the Canje Creek, thence N 42° 43′ 15″ W (Tr) along the right bank of the Canje Creek for a distance of 553.4 feet, thence N 47° 39′ 38″ E (Tr) for a distance of 400 feet to the southern boundary of Grant No. 5060, thence N 77° 52′ 23″ E (Tr) for a distance of 159 feet along the aforesaid southern boundary of Grant No. 5060 to the point of commencement.
