ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER
THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 58).

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Amerindian Village Order, 1960.
2. The portion of the Colony described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be an Amerindian Village.

SCHEDULE

ANNAI AMERINDIAN VILLAGE

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Rupununi River commencing at the mouth of Annai Creek and extending thence down the left bank of the Rupununi River to the mouth of the Kwatomang Creek, thence up the right bank of the Kwatomang Creek for approximately one mile to the mouth of an unnamed tributary, thence in a north-westerly direction to the south-eastern corner of the Annai Airstrip, thence in a south-westerly direction for about one and a quarter miles to the Annai Creek, thence down the left bank of the Annai Creek to the point of commencement, containing an area of approximately 3.52 square miles.
