ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ALIENS (IMMIGRATION AND REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 101).

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE ALIENS (IMMIGRATION AND REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This order may be cited as the Aliens (Immigration and Registration) (Former Somali British Protected Persons) Order, 1960.
2. An alien to whom this Order applies shall, until the 26th day of June, 1961, be exempt from the provisions of sections 5 to 8 of the Aliens (Immigration and Registration) Ordinance which provides for the registration of aliens.
3. This Order shall apply to any alien ordinarily resident in British Guiana on the 26th June, 1960, who immediately before the grant of independence to the Somaliland Protectorate on that day was a British Protected Person for the purposes of the British Nationality Act, 1948, by virtue of his connection with that Protectorate.
