ORDER
MADE UNDER
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280)

UNDER SECTIONS 50 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Parking (Georgetown) (No. 2) Order, 1960.

2. No motor vehicle of any class nor dray cart nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park as follows:—

- (i) in Regent Street between its junction with Orange Walk and its junction with Bourda Street;
- (ii) in Robb Street between its junction with Orange Walk and its junction with Bourda Street;
- (iii) on the western side of Orange Walk between its junction with Regent Street and its junction with Robb Street.
- (iv) on the eastern side of Bourda Street between its junction with Regent street and its junction with North Road.

3. Between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., no motor vehicle of any class, nor any dray cart nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park in America Street between its junction with High Street and its junction with Water Street as follows:—

- (i) on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays on the northern side of the Street;
- (ii) on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays on the southern side of the Street.

4. Paragraph (1) of article 10 of the Parking Places (Georgetown) Order* is hereby varied by —

- (i) the deletion of sub-paragraph (b) thereof; and
- (ii) the renumbering of sub-paragraph (c) thereof as sub-paragraph (b).
