ORDER IN COUNCIL MADE UNDER THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 1) Order, 1960.

2. No carcase whether fresh, frozen, chilled, cured, pickled or smoked of any cattle, pig, sheep or goat, or any portion of such carcase shall be imported into the Colony unless it originates and is imported directly from any of the countries specified in the schedule to this Order:

Provided that nothing in this Order shall prohibit the importation of any such carcase or portion of such carcase that originates in any country specified in the schedule to this Order through any other country specified in the schedule.

3. Nothing in this Order shall prohibit the importation of any carcase or portion of any carcase referred to in the preceding article from any country as commercially canned meat, if it is imported in a hermetically sealed metal can and fully processed in a manner approved by the Director of Agriculture as being satisfactory for the purpose of ensuring that such importation is unlikely to result in the introduction or spread of disease in the Colony, and is accompanied by the Official Meat Inspection Certificate of the country of origin.

4. The Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 2) Order, 1956, is hereby revoked.
