ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 179)

UNDER SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Land of Canaan) Order, 1960.

2. Under section 3 of the above Ordinance, the proposed construction of a canal with dams on both sides and a sluice on the land described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. Under section 4 of the said Ordinance, the Director of Drainage and Irrigation, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or of part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A tract of land being part of Plantation Land of Canaan situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the County of Demerara and the Colony of British Guiana the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at a point along the centre line of the Public Roadway distant 596 ft. north of northern edge of the McLeod trench and proceeding along a line  $S 86^{\circ} 42' W$  to the right bank of the Demerara River, thence along the aforesaid right bank of the Demerara River for a distance of 415 ft. thence along a line  $N 86^{\circ} 42' E$  to a point situated 245 ft. from the centre line of the Public Roadway and on the eastern side of the aforesaid Public Roadway, thence along a line  $S 2^{\circ} 45' E$  for a distance of 55 ft. thence along a line  $N 86^{\circ} 42' E$  to the western toe of the conservancy dam, thence along the aforesaid western toe of the conservancy dam for a distance of 319.4 ft. thence along a line  $S 86^{\circ} 42' E$  for a distance of 7162 ft. thence along a line  $S 2^{\circ} 45' E$  for a distance of 55 ft. thence along a line  $S 86^{\circ} 42' W$  back to the point of commencement.
