THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT

(Cap. 4:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 4 (4) OF THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Recognition of Qualification for Admission to Practise) Order 1983. Citation.

Cap. 4:04

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3 of the Council of Legal Education Act and Paragraph 1 of Article 6 of the Agreement, any national who, on or before 31st December, 1980, satisfied the requirements of any course of legal training which immediately prior to the entry into force of the Agreement would have constituted qualification for admission to practise law in Guyana is hereby declared to be recognised as professionally qualified for admission to practise law in Guyana. Recognition of qualification for admission to practise law.

3. In this order “national” has the same meaning as in Article 6 (2) of the Agreement. Interpretation.
